("Stone Gardens"), whether such climbing activities occur at a Stone Gardens Facility or elsewhere,

Iprint name, hereinafter "the Participant"], the Participant identified above or, if the Participant is a minor, the Participant's Parent, acknowledge, appreciate and agree as follows, for purposes of this Agreement: (these activities will hereinafter be referred to as "climbing activities") Climbing activities include without limitation: bouldering, climbing, belaying, rappelling, use of auto-belays, any practice related to the listed climbing activities, and training of the climbing activities, any team building activities (such as slack-lining), physical fitness training, and recreational games, and any incidental or related activity related to any of the foregoing climbing activities. This includes, but is not limited to, transportation to, access and use of any related facilities in any way. "Parent" means the Participant's parent or court-appointed legal guardian; and "I", "me", myself" and/or, "my" refers to the Participant and, if executed by a Parent, includes both the Parent and the minor.

In consideration of being allowed to participate in any way in the climbing activities of or sponsored by Stone Gardens, Inc.

1. Assumption of Risks.

(a) I fully understand that this Agreement describes some but not all of the risks, hazards, dangers, and potential consequences of the climbing activities, which risk is assumed by the undersigned as set forth in 1(c), which include: (i) Participants making of judgments and decisions as they participate in climbing activities, (ii) Stone Gardens' staff making of judgments and decisions as they instruct and/or assist Participants in climbing activities. Judgments and decisions are by their nature imprecise, in the moment, and potentially subject to error. Judgments and decisions may be made in an environment including routes designed to be challenging, even to very capable and experienced climbers. Participation in climbing activities implicates risk and such risk may increase based on the level of challenge represented by a particular route, whatever the skill of a particular climber. There is also risk that the Participant or a staff member may misjudge, (iii) the Participant's abilities or fitness level, (iv) equipment (including, without limitation: artificial climbing walls, flooring, holds and anchor points, ropes, slings, harnesses, climbing shoes and climbing hardware), (v) whether the Participant's personal equipment or equipment rented or borrowed from Stone Gardens may break, malfunction, fail, or is suitable to the task for which the participant is using said equipment, or is being misused. Stone Gardens makes no warranties, promises, or commitments regarding any equipment, and (vi) the Participant assumes all risks associated with use of equipment. There is the risk that Participant(s) or others may act carelessly or recklessly or generally fail to exercise care. Participant assumes such risks. Some examples include, but are not limited to: (1) failing to clip into the auto-belay device before climbing, (2) clipping the auto-belay device into the wrong part of the harness or into something other than a real harness. These and other risks, hazards and dangers may result in the Participant falling, landing on flooring, becoming entangled in ropes or other equipment, or colliding with objects including artificial climbing walls, holds, anchor points, people, or other objects. The activities, hazards, and other circumstances outlined in this section may result in injury, including fractures, sprains, broken bones, concussions, cuts or abrasions, mental or emotional trauma, paralysis, disability or death or other injury or illness.

(b) Therefore, I fully understand that any instruction, training, orientation, or other information and/or assistance provided by Stone Gardens cannot eliminate such risks. In both supervised and unsupervised climbing activities, I acknowledge that I am responsible for my own safety and, if I am a Parent, the safety of the Participant.

(c) Therefore, I knowingly and voluntarily assume all risks, both known and unknown, disclosed and undisclosed, relating in any way to participation in climbing activities and fully accept responsibility for those risks identified herein, whether express or implicit, for those risks not identified, and for injury, damage, death, or other loss suffered by me and, if I am a Parent, by the Participant, resulting from participation in climbing activities and exposure to it, and/or resulting from my own negligence or other conduct, and/or the negligence of Stone Gardens' employees and/or representatives, or other Stone Gardens' Participants.

2. Release of Liability, Covenant Not to Sue, Waiver of Claims, and Indemnity. For myself and on behalf of my heirs, executors, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin (and, if I am a Parent, also on behalf of my child or ward):
I HAVE FULLY INFORMED MYSELF OF THE CONTENTS OF THIS RELEASE BY READING IT BEFORE SIGNING AND INITIALING. I HEREBY RELEASE, HOLD HARMLESS, WAIVE, INDEMNIFY and covenant not to sue Stone Gardens, its officers, agents, employees, volunteers, representatives, Participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertisers, applicable owners, and lessors of premises used for the climbing activities (hereinafter collectively, the "Releasees"), with respect to any and all liability, any and all claims, including personal injury and death, suits, property damage, costs, and expenses (including attorneys' fees and costs) (hereinafter collectively referred to as "Claims"), arising out of or in any way connected with my participation in the climbing activities at Stone Gardens, and as set forth in section 1, or use of Stone Gardens' equipment and facilities, and as set forth in section 1.

3. Representations. Warranties and Agreements.

I represent, warrant and agree that: (a) my participation in the climbing activities is purely voluntary, and it is my choice to participate in climbing activities regardless of and with knowledge and consent to its risks; (b) I will comply with all rules and regulations of Stone Gardens; (c) I acknowledge that participating in the climbing activities requires a special degree of skill and knowledge different from other activities and that I have responsibilities as a Participant to accurately represent my skill and knowledge. I have no mental or physical problems or limitations that might compromise or affect my ability to participate in the climbing activities or to comply with my responsibilities in connection therewith. I represent that I am fully capable of participating in the climbing activities without causing harm to myself or others. I acknowledge that Stone Gardens' staff is, and have been available to me, to answer any further questions I may have about the nature and physical demands of the climbing activities and the risks, hazards, and dangers associated with the climbing activities. I further promise and warrant that if I observe any unusual significant hazard during my participation, I will remove myself from participation and immediately bring such hazard to the attention of Stone Gardens.

4. Transportation and Medical Care.

Staff of Stone Gardens is authorized to obtain or provide medical care for Participant or to arrange for transport of Participant to a medical facility. Medical personnel are authorized to render such treatment as they deem necessary for Participant's health. Stone Gardens has no responsibility for medical care provided to Participant and I agree to pay all costs associated with such medical care and transportation.

5. Governing Law: Forum.

This Agreement is governed by the laws of the State of Washington. Further, venue for any proceeding arising out of or relating to Participant's participation in the climbing activities must be filed or entered into in King County, State of Washington.

Any portion of this Agreement deemed unlawful or unenforceable shall not affect the enforceability of the remaining provisions of this Agreement and the remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect.
